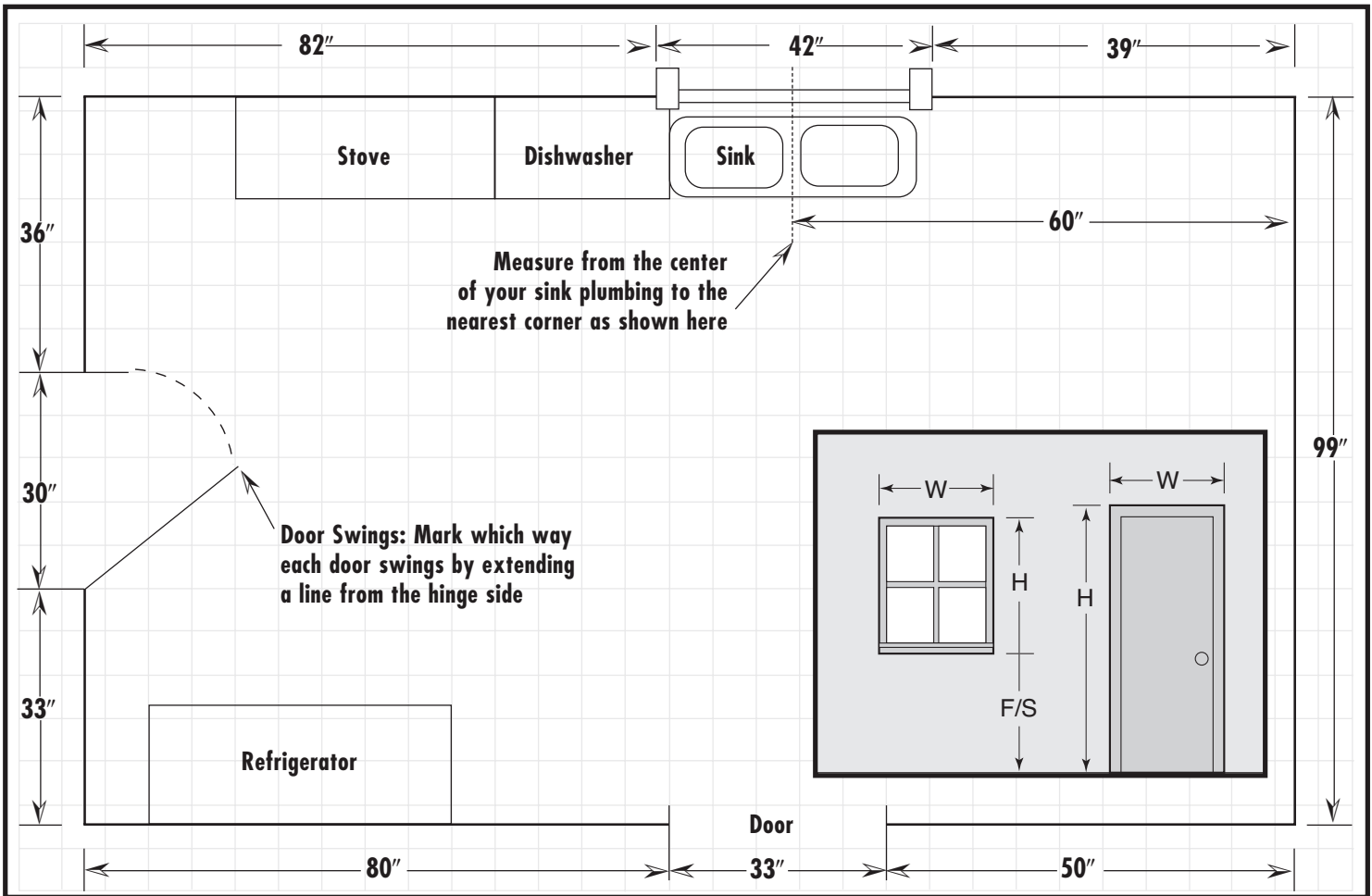


KITCHEN PLANNER



Start by measuring your kitchen—no two kitchens are the same. Our kitchen cabinet representatives are experts in design and need exact dimensions to customize a new kitchen for you. On a separate piece of paper, create a rough drawing of your kitchen following these measuring guidelines.

Step 1: Measure the sink window wall first. Start in the corner. Measure (in inches) to the edge of the window trim.

Step 2: Measure the window. Mark the width from outside of trim to outside of trim. Mark locations of appliances, outlets, and light switches.

Step 3: Working clockwise, record all measurements of the room, noting any "breaks" such as doors, offsets, etc.
